Councilman Nash Continues Partnership With Labor Unions

Councilman Troy Nash, along with several labor unions in the area, including the Carpenter's District Council and the Roofers union Local #20 continue the partnership that began a year ago to renovate dilapidated community centers.

On February 17, 2000, City Councilman Troy Nash and labor leaders from throughout the Kansas City area signed an agreement to renovate several community centers throughout the inner city. Over the past year the unions have donated labor and materials to help renovate run-down community centers and at the same time, provide "hands-on"

training to their new apprentices.

Various unions, including the Carpenter's District Council of Greater Kansas City and Vicinity, IBEW #124, Operative Plasterers' and Cement Masons Local #518, Laborers' Local #663, Bricklayers Allied Craftsmen Union and Roofers Local #20 have done work at the East Area Community center.

"This partnership between the unions and the inner city is one that will benefit the neighborhood and community residents. I really appreciate the time, energy and effort that the unions have put into this project," said Councilman Nash.
