# Former firefighter joins mayoral race

A retired Kansas City firefighter became the last candidate to file for mayor by Tuesday's deadline, joining three other candidates.

Anne Wedow is a former battalion chief in the Fire Department. In January 2002, a federal jury awarded her \$285,000 after she sued the department in a sex discrimination case.

The primary is Feb. 25. The top two vote getters in each race face off in the general election March 25.
