Last targeted building to be razed at 39th and Prospect, Nash says

Kansas City Councilman Troy Nash on Wednesday announced plans to demolish the last targeted building on the corner of 39th Street and Prospect Avenue after \$12,000 was appropriated by the City Council's Neighborhood and Development Committee.

Nash, who represents the long-impoverished area and last summer camped out at the corner to draw attention to its problems, said that three other structures already have been demolished.

The plan is part of a larger initiative to redevelop the Prospect corridor from 25th Street in Midtown to 47th Street on Brush Creek east of the Country Club Plaza.
