Troy Nash Supports More Funding For Fire Stations

City Councilman Troy Nash announced his support for an additional \$350,000 for improvements to be made in Kansas City, Mo., fire department facilities.

"The majority of Kansas City fire stations have suffered deferred maintenance and delayed repair over several decades. Not since the late 1970s has an effort been made to adapt the fire department's infrastructure to the evolution of their enterprise," Nash said.

"I strongly support the additional \$350,000 in funding for new fire department facilities," Nash said. "I have personally visited several fire stations over the past year and believe that now is the time to act. However, while this is a step in the right direction, I believe it falls short of what is needed to provide immediate relief to our men and women in uniform. As a result, I will continue for additional sources of funding," said Nash.
